Have an ATAR that is within 20 points of the lowest selection rank (including adjustments) for that course.

For courses that select on a range of criteria such as folio or interview, SNAP applicants receive equivalent consideration on their performance in these tasks.

Overview

As an Access Melbourne applicant you may be eligible for guaranteed entry to your preferred undergraduate degree with a lower guaranteed ATAR.

Eligibility

Eligible for at least one of the following Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS) categories:

- Disadvantaged financial background.
- Resident of a rural or isolated area.
- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

Applicants will need to meet course prerequisites and achieve the required guaranteed ATAR (2023 ATARs haven't been released yet).

Application

Step 1: check that your course is eligible for Access Melbourne.

Step 2: Apply for the course/s via the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) from Monday 1 August, www.vtac.edu.au

Step 3: Between 1 August – 7 October submit an application via VTAC for the Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS), <https://careernews.click/seas>

ACCESS MELBOURNE – EXPANSION

Overview

Current Year 12 applicants who are eligible for at least one of these four Access Melbourne categories with an ATAR below the usual level selected, may be considered using criteria in addition to ATAR by achieving a (raw) VCE study score of at least 35 in one or more of the VCE Unit 3/4 subjects (or equivalent) specified for their course(s) of interest and providing a personal statement:

- Disadvantaged financial background.
- Resident of a rural or isolated area.
- Difficult circumstances.
- Disability or medical condition.

Step 1: check that your course is eligible.

Step 2: Apply for the course/s via the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) from Monday 1 August, www.vtac.edu.au

Step 3: Between 1 August – 7 October submit an application via VTAC for the Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS), <https://careernews.click/seas>

Step 4: From 1 August complete a VTAC Personal Statement.

MONASH GUARANTEE

Overview

The Monash Guarantee can get you into a Monash course even if you don't reach the course's lowest selection rank. Most undergraduate courses at Monash have a Monash Guarantee ATAR, which is lower than the expected selection rank for that course. For most courses, if you meet the eligibility criteria, achieve the Monash Guarantee ATAR (starting at 70.00), complete all course prerequisites and any additional selection criteria, you will be eligible for a place at Monash.

Benefit

Guaranteed ATAR that is lower than the expected selection rank for the course.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Monash Guarantee, you must:

- be studying an Australian Year 12 or IB in 2022
- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, a holder of Australian permanent residency or permanent humanitarian visa
- satisfy all course-specific prerequisites and requirements
- meet the Monash Guarantee ATAR for your preferred course
- demonstrate that you have experienced financial disadvantage; attend a Monash-listed under-represented school; are an Indigenous Australian; or live in a low socio-economic area.

If you meet the entry requirements, you receive an early offer that guarantees entry to WHITEHOUSE conditional on the completion of Year 12 and any other conditions if they are noted.

When you successfully complete Year 12, your offer becomes unconditional and you are officially a WHITEHOUSE design student!
