VCE prerequisites

Unless stated otherwise, all VCE subjects listed as prerequisites are Units 3+4. This means Year 12 level subjects. All courses listed in this document require the satisfactory completion of VCE Units 3+4 English (any). English (any) includes English (EAL), English, English Language and Literature. Applicants will need to meet minimum English language requirements to be eligible for entry into courses.

Undergraduate course

This is usually your first course at university.

For example - bachelor's degree. You can also become qualified in midwifery through 'graduate entry' studies.

VCE subjects typically aren't taken into consideration as prerequisites.



Boost your Selection Rank!

A Selection Rank is your raw ATAR plus any adjustments (academic and equity) you're eligible for. Universities use your Selection Rank for entry into courses. Did you know you can boost your Selection Rank through achieving academic adjustments for either successfully completing or achieving certain Study Scores in eligible VCE subjects. You may like to take this into consideration when selecting subjects.



Unless stated otherwise, all VCE subjects listed as prerequisites are Units 3+4 (Year 12 level subjects).

English (any) = English, English Language, Literature, or English (EAL).
