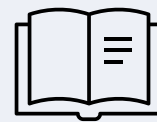

VCE prerequisites

Unless stated otherwise, all VCE subjects listed as prerequisites are Units 3+4. This means Year 12 level subjects. All courses listed in this document require the satisfactory completion of VCE Units 3+4 English (any). English (any) includes English (EAL), English, English Language and Literature.

Undergraduate course

This is usually your first course at university. For example - bachelor's degree. You can also become qualified in paramedicine through 'graduate entry' studies. VCE subjects typically aren't taken into consideration as prerequisites, so these courses haven't been included in this document.

A Selection Rank is your raw ATAR plus any adjustments (academic and equity) you're eligible for. Universities use your Selection Rank for entry into courses. Did you know you can boost your Selection Rank through achieving academic adjustments for either successfully completing or achieving certain Study Scores in eligible VCE subjects.
